

COOKIE POLICY

Biz Bize UK Ltd (“Biz Bize”, “we”, “our” and “us”) uses cookies, web beacons, tracking URLs and similar technologies (collectively referred to as "cookies") to operate, protect, and enhance our website, [\[website\]](#) (the “Site”).

We are committed to being transparent about how we and our partners collect and use data. This Cookie Policy explains how and when we use cookies and your choices regarding these technologies.

Please read this Cookie Policy together with our [Privacy Policy](#), which provides additional information about our use of personal information and any rights you may have in relation to your personal information.

1. What are cookies?

Cookies are small data files that are stored in your browser or on your device. Whenever you visit our Site, these files are saved in your browser folder or on the hard drive of your computer, tablet, or smartphone (collectively referred to as your "**device**"). Each time you return to our Site, the cookies and our Site communicate to recognise your device.

Cookies help us improve the Site and deliver better, more personalised services. For example, they store information about your preferences, enable us to recognise you on your return visits, and make your next experience smoother and more useful.

There are different types of cookies, and their functions vary according to their characteristics. They can remain on your device for different periods of time. Session cookies are automatically deleted when you close your browser, whereas persistent cookies stay on your device for a set period.

We use both first-party and third-party cookies on our Site. First-party cookies are set directly by our Site and transmit information only to us, whereas third-party cookies are set by external organisations and may share cookie-related information with those entities.

2. How we use cookies and similar technologies

We use several types of cookies on our Site, each serving a distinct purpose. Details of the cookies currently in use are provided in the tables below.

Essential Cookies

These Cookies are necessary for the Site to provide core functions and cannot be turned off in our systems. These core functions usually include the main services on

our Site, keeping the Site secure, managing your privacy settings, and allowing you to sign in or fill in forms. These Cookies may be set by us or by third-party providers whose services we use on our Sites. You can set your browser to block or alert you about these Cookies, but some parts of the Site may look odd or might not work at all.

Please note that these Cookies do not collect or store any information that will directly identify you

Analytics Cookies

Analytics cookies are primarily used for analytics in optimising the Site's performance. These Cookies allow us to count visits and behaviours on our Site so we can measure and improve the performance of our Site. They help us to know which pages on our Site are visited the most, which pages are not visited very often, and how visitors move around our Site. This helps us learn what kind of content and site experience visitors enjoy and prefer.
